INFORMATION FOR THE FACULTY :

GUIDELINES TO THE STUDENTS :													
1. Students registering themselves after commencement of classes may be liable to deposit the fine.													
2. All Sessional tests will be of 3 hours duration (ST from Unit 1 & 2 and PUE from the whole syllabus)													
3. All students are required to maintain minimum 75% of attendance (in each theory and practical subjects) before appearing in sessional tests / PUE. List of students having shortage of attendance will be displayed on the departmental notice board before two days from commencement of each sessional exam /tests.													
4. Minimum 75% overall attendance is required to appear in the University End Semester Examinations as per university guidelines.													
5. RAGGING is a punishable offence, all are required to refrain from it. FIR shall be lodged against culprit, as per order of Hon'ble Supreme Court.													
6. All students should keep their weekly test copies in a file.
